Give back: volunteer on ULI's UrbanPlan in UK schools

What is UrbanPlan?

UrbanPlan is the Urban Land Institute's exciting education initiative that's been running successfully in high schools in the US for over ten years.

- It helps young people understand the role real estate plays to revive and regenerate urban areas and it brings to life the urban environment through a series of interactive real life workshops and team working challenges.
- It is designed to enrich the curriculum, develop links between schools and industry and promote careers in real estate too.
- **UrbanPlan** UK offers targeted one-day workshops for year 12 'A' level students (Geography & Business Studies).



ULI will be delivering this innovative programme in schools across the UK from autumn 2015.

The workshop scenario...

- The workshop focuses on the redevelopment of a site in a hypothetical town and students are grouped into teams to form property companies responding to a call for proposals from a fictional local council.
- Each team member assumes a role and through these roles students develop an understanding of the various market and non-market forces and stakeholders in the development process.
- The teams must reconcile the often competing agendas to create a well-designed, market responsive, and sustainable project. Teams address challenging financial, market, social, political, and design issues, develop a 3D model of their plan and present their proposal.

How you can help...

Volunteers are an essential part of UrbanPlan UK and we are seeking volunteers from the property industry from a range of disciplines including surveyors, planners, developers, lawyers, accountants and architects.

The volunteers' role is to:

- Work with students and offer professional advice and guidance.
- Challenge the students to think more critically about the UrbanPlan UK issues and the specific responsibilities of their roles.
- Engage in interactive discussions with students on their project work or specific professional challenges.
- Lead the judging process, listen to student presentations, offer feedback, and choose a winning team.

Volunteers are asked to commit up to two full days, as follows:

- **Preparatory reading (approx. 2 hours)**
- **Volunteer training session (up to 6 hrs)**
- **Workshop delivery in November (1 day – either one whole day or two half days depending on the school)**
- **Judging (2 hours)**

We are keen to identify volunteers who are able to travel if necessary.



Volunteer benefits

Volunteering supports the development of skills such as teamwork, communication, motivating, influencing and negotiating. It also helps you understand your local community better and you'll have an opportunity to interact with, support and learn more about today's teenagers. In particular **UrbanPlan** will give you an opportunity to work with like-minded property industry colleagues, play a part in explaining the role of real estate and to promote property as a possible career. Plus, it's rewarding!

Next steps (2015 roll out)

- ULI will run training sessions for volunteers in October 2015.
- A volunteering handbook will supplement the face-to-face training with practical guidance and advice.
- First workshops to be delivered in schools in November 2015.
